DIPLOMAS

✦ THEOLOGY CERTIFICATE I & II

A Theology Certificate is awarded to a student whose purpose for attending Grace Life University is for their own spiritual growth. Audit Student must complete the first or second year 30 credit-hour program except for taking of tests or quizzes or lab work.

✦ THEOLOGY DIPLOMA

A Diploma in Theology is awarded to a student who successfully completes the first-year 30 credit-hour program.

✦ ASSOCIATES IN THEOLOGY DEGREE

An Associates in Theology Degree is awarded to a student who successfully completes the second-year program for a total of 60 credit hours. At the completion of the program, student is eligible to receive a **certificate of license** to minister the gospel.

✦ ADVANCED, BACHELOR, MASTER OF THEOLOGY DEGREE

An Advanced in Theology Degree and Bachelors in Theology Degree is awarded to a student who completes the third & fourth-year program for a total of 90 & 120 credit hours. For those students with previous theological studies, transfer of credits can be used toward an Advanced, Bachelors or Masters in Theology Degree.

TUITION & REQUIREMENTS

✦ LOW TUITION PLAN

Grace Life University's Tuition Plan is a 'pay-as-you-go' program so that it is affordable to anyone interested. Since each course is completed in one month (four nights, 3 hours each night), you only pay each month at the beginning of each course of study.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

✦ NEW STUDENTS

All applicants entering our Diploma & Associates program must have a high school diploma or (G.E.D.) General Equivalency Diploma. Certificate program students do not need a high school diploma.

APPLICATION PROCESS

✦ NEW STUDENTS

The following steps must be completed for your application to be processed.

1. Fill out application completely. If you are working toward a GLU Degree, please fill out the Grace Life University Student Application Form. If you are working toward a GLU Certificate, please fill out the Grace Life University Audit Application Form.
2. Read all of the Student Handbook and sign Student Handbook Affidavit on last page of this Handbook.
3. Turn in all application forms to your GLU Instructor along with a one-time \$50 Application Fee and your first course tuition of \$220 no later than the first night of class.

STUDENT POLICIES

✦ CONDUCT

Any student that is continually disruptive in class or threatens any student or faculty will be dismissed from GLU. Although we know many students are at different levels of maturity, all students should allow the grace of God to train them to turn away from all ungodliness and allow Jesus to live a holy life through them. As Titus 2:11-14 states...

“For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.”

✦ WOMENS DRESS CODE

Modesty and cleanliness should be your guiding principle. No low cut dresses or necklines or slits above knee are allowed. No flip-flops. Shoes must be worn.

✦ MEN’S DRESS CODE

Well-groomed and cleanliness should be your guiding principle. Beards are to be maintained. No flip-flops or bare feet.

✦ **COURSE REQUIREMENTS**

Each student is required to attend each class, read all the textbooks assigned, take any exams, quizzes or tests and presentations that may be required. Theology Certificate Students are only required to attend and read all the textbooks. After last class, students can turn in a Course Completion Affidavit stating they have completed the Course Requirement and Assigned Reading and have one week after class ends to turn in the Affidavit or course will be graded "Incomplete." Student will have three weeks after last class to complete course and turn in Affidavit or will be graded with an "F." Arrangements will have to be made with the Director for students who cannot attend classes because of an emergency.

✦ **MINISTRY PRACTICUM**

Students are required to serve or volunteer in their local church or ministry for a total of 72 hours within the nine month school year. Students can serve in any department or ministry whether ushers, greeters, nursery, children, media, maintenance etc. After completion, students will receive 3 Credit Hours for their service in their local church or ministry. Reading Program option is available for those who cannot fulfill the 72 hours required. Speak with your Instructor for more information.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

✦ GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The following requirements must be met in order for students to graduate.

1. Students must complete 30 hours of credit for the school year.
2. Students must maintain a 2.0 or greater cumulative grade point average (GPA) for school year.
3. Students must submit Ministry Practicum Log.
4. All tuition and fees must have been paid.
5. Students must submit Course Completion & Graduation Form eight weeks before graduation.

✦ ONLINE STUDENT POLICIES & FEES

The following requirements are specifically for Online Students.

1. Undergraduate Students have 3 months to complete one course.
2. Audit Students have 6 months to complete one course.
3. Course tuition non-refundable once tuition is paid and student has access to course material.
4. If student fails to complete course within time frame and/or withdraws from a course, there will be no academic penalties. Student can pay the tuition and start a course again with a clear academic record.
5. Exams are to be taken from the GLU website and submitted. Along with your Exam, you must also complete an Online Course Completion Affidavit and submit it to GLU.
6. Student must complete 72 hours of volunteer service in order to earn 3 Ministry Practicum credit hours. All hours must be completed before the completion of a Program One or Two and before student can graduate. There is a Reading Program option for Audit students and undergraduate students who for certain reasons cannot fulfill the 72 hours of service. You are to read the whole Bible, from Genesis to Revelation. Reading must be completed plus Reading Program Form turned in to be eligible to graduate.

LIST OF COURSES

THEOLOGY (TH)

✦ **TH-101-THIS IS THE LIFE**

This course is designed to get your heart established in the grace of God.

✦ **TH-102-THE IDENTITY DRIVEN LIFE**

This course helps the student to deal with issues of the past or any form of addiction from an identity driven (who you are in Christ) perspective.

✦ **TH-103-YOUR IDENTITY IN CHRIST**

This course will explain the importance of knowing who you are in Christ and dig deep into God's Word in eight areas of your identity in Christ.

✦ **TH-104-UNVEILING JESUS**

This powerful course will help the student to get a solid scriptural foundation in seeing Jesus in the wonderful light of His grace.

✦ **TH-205-GRACE IN THE OLD TESTAMENT I**

The purpose of this course is to walk the student through the Old Testament in order to show God's grace demonstrated in every book. We will take the journey like Jesus did when He explained to the disciples everywhere where it was written about Him in the Law, Prophets and the Psalms.

✦ **TH-206-GRACE IN THE OLD TESTAMENT II**

The purpose of this course is to continue our walk the through the Old Testament in order to show God's grace demonstrated in every book.

✦ **TH-207-GRACE IN THE OLD TESTAMENT III**

The purpose of this course is to continue our walk the through the Old Testament in order to show God's grace demonstrated in every book.

✦ **TH-208-GRACE BASED PRAYER**

This is course will give you a fresh understanding of how to pray scripturally based prayers. Many are praying prayers today asking God to do something that He has already done.

✦ **TH-209-GRACE AMBASSADORS TRAINING**

This course is designed to train the student on how to share the gospel of grace, how to disciple new believers and how to prepare and deliver sermons. The course also gives instruction on water baptisms, communion, funerals, weddings and pre-marital counseling.

✦ **TH-210-GRACE LEADERSHIP**

This course is designed to train the student on how to walk in effective grace-based leadership. You will learn leadership lessons from the lives of Moses, King David and other leaders in the Bible and how to win over discouragement, depression and burnout.

✦ **TH-311-DIVINE HEALTH**

This course reveals God's will for believers to not only be healed but to walk in divine health and also shares different ways that healing can manifest in one's body.

✦ **TH-312-DIVINE PROSPERITY**

This course is designed to reveal God's will for believers to prosper. Like Abraham, God always blesses us first so that we can be a blessing. The blessing always comes first, then the multiplication. Father God is the greatest of all givers and as his children, His love for us motivates us to give, prosper and be a blessing to our families and the kingdom of God.

✦ **TH-313-GRACED FAMILIES**

This course is designed to train the student on building a strong marriage, learn principles on parenting, step-parenting, and what God's word says to singles.

✦ **TH-314-SUCCESS PRINCIPLES FROM PROVERBS & ECCLESIASTES**

Proverbs and Ecclesiastes are books of wisdom. There are many principles in these two books that will help you lives a successful and prosperous life for your Lord Jesus Christ.

✦ **TH-315-DREAMS, VISIONS & SERVANT LEADERSHIP**

God has a plan, dream and vision for every believer. This course will teach you how to find it and see it come to pass in your life plus you will learn the many important truths about servant leadership. Those that are called to lead are called to serve.

✦ **TH-316-UNDERSTANDING END TIMES PROPHECY**

Many now realize we are living in the end of the age of grace. This course will give you the basics of understanding end times prophecy and the sequence of end time events so you can encourage others about the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ for His saints and the coming Tribulation and Millennium.

✦ **TH-417-THE MINISTRY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT**

This course will teach you about the Holy Spirit and how the Holy Spirit works in believers today to fulfill God's plans and purposes for our lives.

✦ **TH-418- THE TEACHINGS OF JESUS**

This course goes over the basic teachings of Jesus in the 4 Gospels. You will learn why He spoke the way He did and the purposes of the many parables that He shared.

✦ **TH-419-CHURCH HISTORY**

This course helps believers to understand how the church started and how the church lived and survived and went through many different challenges and changes up till our generation.

✦ **TH-420-BIBLICAL VS. WORLD VIEWS & WORLD RELIGIONS**

This course is teaches what the Bible has to say about social issues like abortion, marriage between a man and a woman, race relations and other issues. It also covers the different world religions so that the student can have a basic understanding of the different religions to be equipped minister God's Word in a proficient way

BIBLICAL INSTRUCTION (BI)

✦ **BI-104-JOHN: GRACE & TRUTH MANIFESTED**

This course is a verse by verse study of the Gospel of John where Jesus and His grace and truth are manifested in everything that Jesus is to the world.

✦ **BI-106-ROMANS: RIGHTEOUSNESS REVEALED**

This course is a verse by verse study of the Book of Romans where the Apostle Paul reveals the gospel of grace in a clear and systematic manner. This book is foundational in understanding the gospel of the grace of God.

✦ **BI-109-GALATIANS: GRACE – APOSTOLIC FOUNDATIONS**

This course is a verse by verse study into the strongest epistle by the Apostle Paul in defense of the gospel of God's grace and explains the importance of staying free from the law and walking in the spirit.

✦ **BI-110-EPHESIANS: A GLORIOUS CHURCH**

This course is a verse by verse study by the Apostle Paul into the riches of God's grace in our identity in Christ and the practical application of who we are and what we have in Christ.

✦ **BI-119-HEBREWS: NEW COVENANT, NEW GLORY**

This course in Hebrews was written to Christian Jews who were wanting to go back to Judaism because of persecution so Paul explains to them how Jesus and the New Covenant is so much better than all the things they had when they were under the Old Covenant of Law.

✦ **BI-205A-ACTS: TURNING THE WORLD UPSIDE DOWN I**

This course is a verse by verse study of the early church and how the gospel of God's grace first began to be spread throughout the known world.

✦ **BI-205B-ACTS: TURNING THE WORLD UPSIDE DOWN I**

This course continues the verse by verse study of the early church and how the gospel of God's grace first began to be spread throughout the known world.

✦ **BI-308-1 CORINTHIANS: GODS GRACE AT WORK**

1st & 2nd Corinthians were written by Paul to deal with the many issues that the new Church in Corinth was dealing with. Those who were being saved had many questions about their new walk with God in the midst of this very worldly pagan city. Many practical topics are covered in 1st Corinthians like division, avoiding worldly wisdom, immorality, taking believers to court, marriage, work life, dealing with weak Christians, using gifts wisely, walking in love, order of meetings, giving, and handling ministerial issues.

✦ **BI-309-2 CORINTHIANS: GOD'S GRACE AT WORK**

2nd Corinthians deals with the areas of God's comfort, forgiveness and reconciliation, God's glory revealed in the New Testament & in Jesus Christ, the gospel of grace, holiness in ministry and personal life, the grace of giving, spiritual warfare, suffering for Christ's sake and the sufficiency of His grace.

✦ **BI-313-1 & 2 THESSALONIANS: WORKING & WAITING FOR HIS RETURN**

This course is a verse by verse study of the books of 1 & 2 Thessalonians. The Thessalonian church was a very young church and Paul could not stay there long because of persecution coming against him. Paul wrote them to encourage them in their service to the Lord and in waiting for the Lord's return.

✦ **BI-411-PHILIPPIANS: UNITY & JOY IN CHRIST JESUS**

This course is a verse by verse study of the book of Philippians. Philippians is one of Paul's prison epistles. The Philippian church had become dear to Paul because they were the only church who proved their love to him by partnering with him and his ministry financially. The theme of Philippians is finding unity and joy in Christ Jesus so Paul encourages them to stay united and joyful in the Lord.

✦ **BI-412-COLOSSIANS: JESUS CHRIST REIGNS OVER ALL**

This course is a verse by verse study of the book of Colossians written to show that Jesus Christ is Lord of all and reigns over all, the world, the church, our lives and that we should not allow the philosophy of the world to distract us from the truth that we are filled with the Godhead and complete in Christ Jesus.

✦ **BI-415-1 & 2 TIMOTHY & TITUS, 1, 2, 3 JOHN**

This course is a verse by verse study through the pastoral epistles to Timothy & Titus, Paul's companions and sons in the faith. 1, 2, and 3 John were letters written by the Apostle John to deal with a heretical movement in the early church called Gnosticism which did believe Jesus Christ came in the flesh and John also God's amazing love for us.

✦ **BI-421-1 & 2 PETER: GRACE FOR SUFFERING & GROWING**

This course is a verse by verse study of the books of 1 & 2 Peter. 1 Peter deals with submission and suffering for the Lord's sake. While 1 Peter deals with problems and trials coming from the outside, 2 Peter deals with problems coming from the inside. Peter also shares that Jesus is coming for us and to judge the world so we must continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ in these end times.

✦ **BI-427-THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST**

This course is a verse by verse study through the book of Revelation. The book of Revelation is a prophetic book that reveals the end of the age of Grace, the Tribulation Period, the 1,000 Year Millennium and the future New Heavens and New Earth.

CHRISTIAN COUNSELING (CC)

✦ **CC-201-COUNSELING GOD'S WAY**

This course is designed to help the student to admonish and counsel those in need in a scriptural way with an identity in Christ perspective. This course includes the "Christian Counselor's Companion Manual."

MINISTRY PRACTICUM (MP)

✦ **MP-101, MP-202, MP-303, MP-404**

These are the three credit-hour course credit students receive for completing 72 hours of volunteer service in their local church or ministry.

READING PROGRAM (RP)

✦ **RP-101, RP-202, RP-303, RP-404**

These are the three credit-hour course credit students receive for Audit students and undergraduate students who for certain reasons cannot fulfill the 72 hours of service. Students are to read the whole Bible, from Genesis to Revelation which takes an average of 72 hours to complete.
